

Continuum of Care

Created by the state legislature in 1983, COC's mission is to ensure continuing development and delivery of appropriate services to those children with the most severe and complex emotional or behavioral health challenges whose needs are not being adequately met by existing services and programs.

In order to carry out this mission, the COC provides intensive care coordination through a care planning process called Wraparound. Wraparound is a team based approach to caring for families with complicated needs.



The single most important outcome of the Wraparound approach is a child thriving in their home with their family and maintained by normal community services and supports.

What is Wraparound?

High Fidelity Wraparound is a team-based care-coordination approach that involves children, families, supports, and professional service providers.

Wraparound is for children with serious emotional or behavioral health diagnoses whose family's need assistance keeping their children in their home, school, or community.

If a child is currently out of their home or community, Wraparound can assist with planning for a successful return to his/her family, school, and friends.



Typically, a child spends 12 to 18 months in Wraparound. The Child & Family team meets once a month until they decide that the child is ready to transition out of the program and Wraparound care coordination is no longer needed.

Wraparound has been shown to help avoid out of home placement, improve school attendance and performance, decrease interactions with the legal system, and enhance a family's overall quality of life.

Who provides Wraparound?

Wraparound Facilitators are the experts in the Wraparound process. They are located at the COC regional offices and lead team meetings for children and their family. They coordinate care and make sure families have access to the support they need.

What happens in Wraparound?

There are four unique phases to the process:

1. Engagement & Team Preparation

The family and the Wraparound Facilitator get to know one another and the family chooses Wraparound team members. This happens within a month of the referral.

2. Initial Plan Development

This begins at your first Wraparound team meeting. Along with your team, you will create a team mission, brainstorm ways to meet the needs of the youth involved, and create outcomes that can be measured throughout the process.

3. Plan Implementation

Phase three consists of team meetings every 30 days. They start with what the team has accomplished over the past month. The Wraparound team will then assess whether the plan in place works or doesn't work, adjust the plan if needed, and assign new responsibilities for team members to ensure plan completion.

4. Transition

While we recognize transitions happens throughout Wraparound, there will be a time when a family no longer needs the COC staff and the team won't need to meet regularly. This is a great accomplishment. The Wraparound team will make a plan for the future.
